**GSU EXPLORES THE WONDERS OF THE SEA AT GSU NIGHT AT THE AQUARIUM**

Atlanta, GA – January 25, 2012 – Campus Events invites Georgia State University (GSU) students, faculty, staff, and friends to attend the annual GSU Night at the Aquarium on Friday, February 15, 2013 from 6 p.m. to 11 p.m. at the Georgia Aquarium.

Experience the world's largest aquarium with access to all of the Georgia Aquarium's free exhibits including the traveling exhibit, *Frogs, a Chorus of Colors*, and other fun activities like *Deepo's Undersea 3D Wondershow*, face painting, a scavenger hunt, and live music. There will be one showing of the AT&T Dolphin Tales Show (additional ticket purchase required) at 7:30 p.m.; seating for this show will begin at 7 p.m. and late entry is not permitted.

Tickets are now on sale at Campus Tickets in the University Center. Campus Tickets is open Monday through Friday, from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. Ticket sales are not restricted to GSU students, faculty, and staff; friends and family of GSU are invited to attend. The early bird ticket prices are as follows: \$13 per person for Aquarium entry only; \$21 per person for entry to the Aquarium and the AT&T Dolphin Tales show. On February 1<sup>st</sup>, ticket prices will increase as follows: \$16 per person for Aquarium entry only, and \$26 for entry to the Aquarium and the AT&T Dolphin Tales show. Children two years and under are admitted for free.

Campus Events is providing free shuttles to transport ticket holders between the GSU campus and the Aquarium from 5 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on February 15<sup>th</sup>. Shuttles will depart from the Student Center and University Commons and will drop off near the Aquarium's front entrance. The last shuttle will leave the Aquarium at 11:30 p.m. to bring guests back to campus. Free parking is available at the M Deck beginning at 5 p.m. for persons with a GSU Night at the Aquarium ticket. Parking is available at the Aquarium for \$10 per vehicle.

GSU Night at the Aquarium is a part of GSU's Centennial Celebration.
